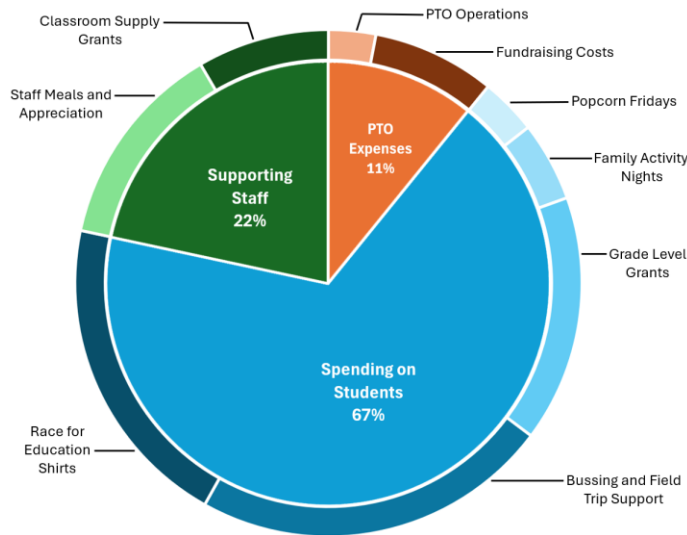

What does the PTO do for Washington Elementary?

The PTO's mission unites parents and teachers to support all of Washington's students. We accomplish our goals by fundraising throughout the school year and then allocating those funds directly to student, staff, and building needs and activities.

What does that look like? Last year Washington's parents and community helped us raise more than \$23,000. That money supported teachers by purchasing classroom supplies and catering staff meals. Most benefits went directly to students, as we bought everything from books and safety equipment to pumpkins and caterpillars. Our largest expense was paying for all field trip transportation, lowering costs for Washington families and ensuring access to fun and educational trips for every student.

What's in store for this school year?

Our goal for the '25-26 school year is to make the PTO bigger and better than ever. Of course we'll continue purchasing classroom supplies, funding grade level grants, and paying for field trip transportation – providing all the support we do every year. But we have some bigger ideas too:
