1. Call to Order @ 5:17 PM
2. Welcome
3. Reading and Approval of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting
  - a. **October Minutes – approved.**
  - b. **December Minutes – playground supplies, spent \$350 not \$600. Approved.**
4. Report of the Officers
  - a. President
    - i. Popcorn Friday needs
      1. **April – sponsor and 1 volunteer**
      2. **May – need 1 volunteer**
    - ii. Restaurant fundraisers update
      1. **Culvers - \$739.70**
      2. **Rocky's - \$435.00. They said it had never been that busy! They comp'd some \$\$ because they were unable to take some orders.**
      3. **Dunkin' and Baskin Robins coming up Thursday March 5<sup>th</sup>. 5-8pm. This is more of an event, games, etc. We'll see how this goes, since it's more of a breakfast thing? Don't need any staffing/volunteers. 10% of sales come back to PTO.**
  - b. Vice President – unable to attend, sharing some info she gave the other officers.
    - i. **Volunteers for teacher appreciation week: 4<sup>th</sup> through the 8<sup>th</sup> of May. Usually been a group of like 4 parents who try and do things each day, like coffee and donuts, Gift card raffle, etc.**
  - c. Treasurer
    - i. Treasurer report
      1. **Restaurant Fundraising goal is \$2500; we're already at \$2400 or so; so that's great.**
      2. **Popcorn income – still needing one more sponsor... Mrs Burger volunteers! No more sponsors needed!**
    - ii. Raising for Risers
      1. **Just over \$4200 raised so far.**
      2. **Submitted application to community foundation to support the campaign. Should hear back end of the month. Even if they don't fund it, should get our project out on a mailing list.**

3. Would like to “re-invigorate” the group asking local businesses. We’ve hit school community plenty, especially with Race for Education coming up, so trying to split our fundraising efforts, make sure we’re not double dipping.
4. Brief discussion around total: does the PTO want to totally cover the remaining balance from our reserve funds at the end of the year? IE, keep fundraising through the year, but then cover what’s needed to make the purchase at the end of the year.
  - a. Spring concert K-2, May 8<sup>th</sup>.
    - i. Touch base with Alli before concert to make sure right sponsors are on the program.
    - ii. Invite sponsors/grandparents/community to the concert.
  - iii. Other expense items:
    1. Classroom supply grants: up to \$700 out of \$3000
    2. Still lots of bussing/fieldtrips left, but lots of fieldtrips planned this Spring.
    3. Grade level supply grants: \$600 so far, a few more in progress.
- d. Secretary
  - i. Lots of website updates happening
  - ii. What do we need to add/put on the 2026 Race for Education page?
    1. Rain date
    2. What does money go for
    3. Once the 99 pledges is up, the link for that and how to use
  - iii. Should make the link to the Race for Education its own thin banner across top of the site.

### a. Budget requests for 2026-27

- i. Budget last year (for this year) was only created/approved by officers in June. We would like to present a proposed budget at the last PTO meeting in May, so we're asking for feedback/ideas now, especially from teachers.
  - 1. Could PTO just pay for whole field trips?
  - 2. Let's survey each grade level, what did they spend on field trips this year?
- ii. Clarify: even this year; classroom grants can be rolled into whatever the teachers want, so it can be doubled into field trips, etc. Grade level grants same thing.
